Remaining Nine Homes Unveiled At Skylofts, 145 Hudson Street



A collection of stunning new lofts has recently come on the market in TriBeCa. Skylofts at 145 Hudson Street, the building that sold its penthouse for a record \$30 million in 2009, has unveiled its remaining nine lofts, according to Stribling Marketing Associates, which is handling the sales and marketing for the development.

Located in the historic Art Deco loft building, the new lofts, which were designed by interior architect Rogers Marvel Architects, surpass the expectations of TriBeCa loft spaces with soaring ceilings, magnificent exposures and oversized windows. Bold original architectural elements such as poured concrete ceilings and broad columns tell the story of Skyloft's rich industrial past.

"As you walk into these lofts, you will be impressed by the immense feeling of space, the tremendous light pouring in, and most importantly, the attention to every detail within the homes," said Sean Murphy Turner, Executive Vice President of Stribling Marketing Associates.
